'F' team of Gordon Langshaw, Eric Spencer, Adewuyi Olorun'femi', and Sharon Mahon played one of this season's new teams, Maghull 'F's Phil Carlin and 3 youngsters Luke Courtney, Michael Stewart and Danny Hall, level pegging all the way to the final doubles match, Maghull winning the first call each time, Labour pulling it back level, with the final doubles match between experience and defence, (Gordon and Eric) v youth and attack, (Luke and Michael), experience coming out top in the end 3-1, but I'm sure everyone enjoyed the match and tension. But congratulations to the boys of Maghull, who will need to be taken very seriously next season after a season 'finding their feet'.
