Match 2. - Bath St. Marine 2's Colin Owens, Dave Stoddern and Dave Noden (138), started with a 52 point lead over Maghull 2's John Langton, Rod Bulmer and George frost (86), BsM were in control most of the match, winning 11 of the games, increasing the gap to 66 points.

Match 3. - Marconi 1's Ray Jackson, Adrian Bramham and Ian Wensley (21) had a 58 point start over Bootle YMCA 1's Keith Williams, Wayne Percival and Alan Chase (- 37), Marconi held on to their lead to set 7, when Alan took the YM into an 8 point lead, One later, the lead changed back with Adrian beat Wayne both games 16, so into the last set between Ray and Keith, Marconi 2 in front, cat amongst the pigeons, ray wins the first game 21-20, all on the last game now, is Keith down! no just a change of gear, taking the last game 21-7, to give YM the match by 11 points, must have been a 'good un'.

Match 7. - M/Police 2's Brenda Buoeuy, Tom Purcell and Geoff Pye (98) gave Bootle YMCA 2's Bert Rivers, Eddie Preston and Mike Hughes (134) a 36 point start, after 3 sets BYM were hanging on with just 1 point in front, match was settled after the next set, lead changing to Police, 19 in front, only blip was Eddie beating Tom 42-30 in the 8th set, into the last set Police are 38 in front and no pressure on Brenda, but increases the lead anyway to give the Police the match by 46 points.
