



Liverpool & District Table Tennis League Cup Finals & Venues – Season 2009-10



Dear Club Secretaries

Divisional Finals have arrived again, this year all finals will be played in the same week, beginning with The Division 1 Readman Cup on Monday 22nd March, please make sure your team captains and players are made aware of the relevant Rules, particularly starting time!!, be early.

Cup Reg. 7. All players taking part in a cup match must be present and available to play at 7.30 pm. Any player not available at the stipulated time when called upon to play shall forfeit such set unless a reserve is available, who once introduced, shall play for the rest of the cup match.

Cup Reg. 5. A player, whose registration is received by the Fixture Secretary after 31st December, shall not be eligible to play in a cup match except by permission of the Management Committee.

Cup Reg. 5a. A player is not eligible to play in a Cup Final unless he/she has played for their club a number of League matches equivalent to 45% of League matches played by the team appearing in the Final, rounded down to the nearest whole number.

Cup Reg. 5b. A player may not play in a Cup Final if his/her eligibility to do so has been obtained by playing for one or more higher team/s during the preceding four calendar weeks.

Match Reg.10 (b) Cup matches shall be best of nine (9) sets. In 3-a-side divisions there shall be no doubles event. In 4-a-side divisions there shall be eight (8) singles and one doubles event. Composition of doubles pair is the Captain's choice. Only players used in singles events may comprise a doubles pairing.

The **Frank Murphy Memorial Handicap Trophy** will be played under the Veteran Cup Regulations as normal, shown on pages 23 & 24 of the Rule Book

By 7-25 pm, - team match cards will be exchanged with the Match Official, and at 7-30pm,- coin will be tossed to decide home and away team, (away team has first choice), and match will commence.

Please ensure your players are eligible to play by reference to the rulebook. If in doubt please contact a member of the Rules Committee. If an ineligible player takes part in a match, the game will be awarded to your opponents.
